When SquareHit Tennis sent me their new invention back in October, I was eager to try it out to see if it held up to its claims. According to the company, the WristAssist enables you to “feel what the pros feel” by placing your wrist in the correct hitting position to consistently square the racquet face to the ball for a solid, powerful stroke.



The product comes in a small, attractive package and is ready to use out of the box. I was pleasantly surprised when I first tried out the device. The actual product is durable and will stay secure on your wrist for an entire hitting session. Although very helpful on all strokes, I found the WristAssist to be most effective on volleys. The product encourages you to have a solid, compact swing and does not allow you to be wristy. It is also helpful for eliminating bad habits in your swing. By consistently reinforcing a good swing path through the critical “impact zone,” the WristAssist allows you to build pure, sound strokes quickly. One of the only downfalls of the product is that you need to change the configuration of the product on your racquet when changing to another stroke, but that is expected since you are changing grips. Overall I highly recommend the product. It really earns a five star review for a reason.

SquareHitTennis has strong backing of their product as it is endorsed by Brad Gilbert. If you don't know Brad, he is considered one of the greatest tennis minds of all time and reached a career high of number four in the 1989 ATP Rankings. He is the former coach of Andre Agassi and now works with Andy Murray and the British LTA. According to BG, “The SquareHit WristAssist is an incredibly powerful tennis training tool.
