Many players can control their larger body parts while hitting a ground stroke, yet find it extremely difficult keeping their smaller body parts like the wrist and forearm from moving too much through the shot. Taking tennis lessons while growing up, I remember my instructor prefacing certain drills by saying, "if you can control your hands, you can control your racket; if you can control your racket, you can control the ball, if you can control the ball, you control your opponent; control the opponent, you control the match." Most club level players and juniors, it seems, have a great deal of trouble controlling their racket, because the wrist position is not learned or controlled.

The WristAssist helps to train the wrist to stay in that "L" position many instructors will tell you about in lessons. You can easily control the tension of the device by simply moving your hand up and down the grip.
